Tens of thousands of people demonstrated across the United Kingdom Saturday against British Prime Minister Boris Johnson's plans to cut shot parliamentary debate to push through Brexit, the New York Times (https://www.nytimes.com/2019/08/31/world/europe/boris-johnson-protest.html) reports.

Why it matters: Per the NYT, protesters regard Johnson's plans to suspend parliament for a period just before Britain's Oct. 31. deadline for exiting the European Union as antidemocratic.
